What would you like to do?

If the answer is “I want to be a pilot” then wherever you are in your flight training, we will take you step-by-step through every phase to make it easier for you to learn to fly. Flying is very special, but that does not mean it is hard to do. If becoming a pilot, and learning more about aviation and flying is something you have always dreamed of, you can start today!

Take a look at this section to see what it really takes to start flying lessons and choose a route that is right for you. We will work with you to ensure that your experience is worry free so that you can enjoy your flight training with us.

If you would like to discuss details of starting or continuing your training towards a PPL (or NPPL) than please ask to speak to one of our instructors. Details of training rates and requirements can be found at the end of this newsletter.

Option A : 30 minute trial lesson

This flight takes the form of a thirty minute "mini" flying lesson. You will fly with a professional flying instructor in a fully certified training aircraft. If you feel comfortable, you will actually do most of the flying during the flight as well! In addition to the flight we will explain the pre-flight inspection, get you to help the pilot check the aircraft, and then you can run through the checklists before you start the engine!

Option B : 1 hour trial lesson

If you are really keen to see what learning to fly is all about then this flight gives you an excellent introduction. You will cover everything that we do on our 30 minute flight, but you will be doing this while on a short cross country exercise. En route, your instructor will demonstrate various aspects of what it takes to pilot a light aircraft safely and you will be able to take the controls and follow through. Before you know it you will have completed your first hours training and, if you like, enter this into your logbook as part your training record towards your PPL.

Option A : Air experience trial flight

This flight takes the form of a thirty minute local flight where you will get the chance to take the controls as a part of your trial flight experience. Depending on weather, you will fly to various local attractions such as Whitby, Durham Cathedral or the spectacular local scenery of the North York Moors and coastline. You will fly with a professional flying instructor in a fully certified training aircraft. Much more than just a pleasure trip, you will experience what it is really like to fly. Once back on the ground, a certificate is awarded to remember the experience.

Why not fly for longer and take in more sights or travel further and give yourself more time to have a go at flying. Opt for a one hour flight.

Want to go with family or friends? Then one of our 4 seater aircraft will provide extra room and comfort. Opt for a 4 seater.

Option B : Aerobatic flight - Bulldog

Want to experience the ultimate or the excitement of flying in a classic high performance aircraft? Then an aerobatic air experience flight in the School Scottish Aviation ex-RAF Bulldog may be for you. In addition to option A above you can, if you wish, experience some basic aerobatics including looping the loop and rolls. Choose from a 30 minute or one hour flight. Once back on the ground, a certificate is awarded to record your achievement.

Option C : Helicopter flight - Robinson

A flight in any helicopter is a unique and unforgettable experience. Hovering above scenic landmarks on a fascinating and exhilarating flight, you have the opportunity to see sites from a new perspective which you would never manage to see from the ground or from an aeroplane. A helicopter air experience flight is a great introduction to these amazing flying machines.

Why not fly for longer and take in more sights or travel further? Opt for a one hour flight. If you want to go with family or friends then one of our 4 seater helicopters will provide the room and comfort.

CFS latest news

Cleveland flying school is now one of the largest private flying and flight training organisation in the north of England. Currently, we have more than 150 members and are also active training students from Leeds University as the preferred training provider in the North for the University. With now well over 100 university students trained to PPL level and beyond in the past 3 years, CFS have demonstrated both the consistency and quality of their training approach, from which you can also benefit by choosing to fly with us.



The dedicated University Flight Training fleet at Cleveland Flying School is currently made up of four Cessna 152s. These aircraft are in addition to the aircraft used for general PPL, private hire and the other training that we offer. Coupled with dedicated instructors, the Leeds operation does not impact on our other training.

The Cessna 152 is one of the best small 4-cylinder engine aeroplanes in use for basic training to PPL level.

Small Cessnas in one form or another have served as the standard flying school aeroplane for decades and more pilots have learned to fly in this type worldwide than just about any other aircraft. The Cessna Aircraft Company, founded by Clyde Cessna, is one of the largest producers of small aeroplanes in the world. The Cessna 150/152 series of aircraft quickly became a major success for the company with a production run spanning several decades. The Cessna 152 is a very robust, yet forgiving all-metal two-seater trainer, with a high-wing design, that now looks very familiar, which gives it excellent stability.

CFS plan to add further aircraft to the University Flight Training fleet over the next three years in line with the numbers of students in training and going forward into the future and already have on order the new model Cessna C162 Skycatcher due for delivery in 2010.
